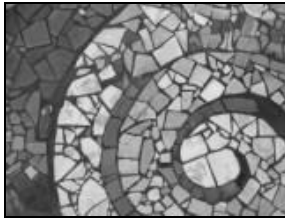

**Aims and Scope:** *LATCH: A Journal for the study of the Literary Artifact in Theory, Culture, or History* seeks to showcase scholarly writing that examines how texts both shape and are shaped by the material and ideological currents of their own time or of the past. Since texts cannot stand above the constraints and influences of their socio-historical settings, a research emphasis on how and where the nonliterary invades, supports, illuminates, or undermines the literary can only enrich the ongoing study of the intertextuality of literature.

**Instructions to Authors:** Submissions must be written in English and organized according to the MLA (7<sup>th</sup> ed.) method of format and documentation. The acceptable length of submissions is roughly from ten to thirty single-spaced pages, including footnotes (no endnotes please). The writing style must render the essay accessible to the generally educated layperson; therefore, the initial instances of technical jargon or diction germane to one academic discipline, if such terms are necessary to the argument, should be defined in the text or in footnotes. Discriminatory or socially inappropriate language will be rejected. All submissions must be electronically submitted.

**Indexing Services:** *LATCH* is indexed in the MLA International Bibliography and is provided full text in EBSCO's Humanity International.
